Research England | Knowledge Exchange:

- Knowledge Exchange: [when universities] work with many different types of partner to ensure that [new and useful] knowledge can be used for the benefit of the economy and society
- **Range:** From individual members of the public who may attend events organised by a university, to a multinational company partnering with a university to develop new medicines.

Activities such as:

- public events
- sharing access to specialist equipment or facilities
- undertaking consultancy
- licensing intellectual property
- serving as anchor institution (local, regional)

Some exclusions

- Research that does not involve an external partner, eg collaborative research with another higher education provider only.
- Teaching that does not involve an external partner, eg cross-disciplinary curriculum development.
- Capital expenditure such as building construction or refurbishment.
- Duplication of activity that could be covered through other sources of funding

- Research administration such as the preparation of impact statements (although KE activities to achieve the impact would be eligible).
- Outreach programmes that are primarily aimed at student recruitment or widening participation.
- PhD studentships, tuition or bench fees
- Indirect or estates costs

New partners

It will be advantageous if external organisations have at least completed the EOI form for Knowledge Hub partnerships.
